- Choose a small group of volunteers from the larger group.
- Ask the volunteers to tag the rest of the group, who are trying to get past them to the other end of the space.
- Whoever gets tagged joins the volunteers, making the task of getting past harder as the game wears on .
- Whoever is last to be tagged wins the game, and becomes the first volunteer for the next round.

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## TWO HANDS

- Divide the group into two teams.
- Have one team put a small object in each hand.
- Show the objects to the opposite team. Everyone looks at them for one minute, then close all hands.
- The leader then asks questions to the opposite team in turn e.g. "What has Emma got in her right hand?" or "Who had a paper clip?"
- The team with the most points earned at the end wins!

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## CHARADES

- Select two even teams.
- Choose a player from one of the teams. This player has a limited period of time to 'act out' a phrase to his teammates. They cannot speak, make a sound, point to or use any objects in the room to help.
- A point is awarded once the team successfully guesses the phrase within the time. The teams take turns until each team member has had an opportunity to charade.



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
