

# ICE BREAKER GAMES



## Who am I -

### You will need

- Cut out pictures from old magazines. Pictures can be of anything (e.g. cars, bananas, kittens, carrots, a baby).
- Tape



### How to Play

- Keeping the pictures hidden, tape one picture on each child's back. Make sure they don't know what the picture is.
- Each child takes turns asking questions to help them figure out what is on the picture. The questions must be answered with a yes or no. If the answer is yes, another question can be asked. If the answer is no, the next person takes a turn.
- When a picture has been correctly guessed, tape another picture onto their back.
- Play the game for a set amount of time (about 10 - 15 minutes) or until everyone has figured out at least one picture.

### Questions

Here are some ideas of questions that can be asked:

- Am I alive?
- Can I be eaten?
- Do I have fur?
- Do I need petrol?

Once there is an idea about what the object is, they can ask about more specific details.
